PERFORMANCE NOTES

I saw a new heaven and a new earth was written as a processional for an Advent Service. These verses from Revelation 21 which speak of the "Second Coming", a major theme in Advent, are also most appropriate for All Saints Day. In addition this text is appointed for the second reading on the Fifth Sunday of Easter, Cycle C in both the Roman Catholic and Lutheran lectionaries. Thus this work would be most suitable on these occasions as well.

Though conceived for performance by two choirs—an equal voice choir with handbells making a procession and a mixed choir remaining in a fixed place—this processional may be performed with a mixed choir singing both parts.

The handbell parts are optional. They may be further simplified by omitting the first two peals in each of the unison verses. The optional bells are shown in small notes on the staff below.
